Dress Code Policy

Please review our Bible Camp policy to ensure you and your camper are prepared with the appropriate attire.

- Modesty is expected at all times.
- No visible midriffs. Clothing that exposes any part of the mid- section when standing, sitting, or bending over will not be allowed.
- All tops should be long enough to be tucked in if necessary.
- Shorts must be fingertip length at least when standing straight, arms to the side. This is measured from the shortest part of the shorts. Running shorts will not be allowed due to the short nature, even if they are long enough.
- Skin-tight or otherwise revealing clothing will not be allowed. Low-cut shirts, spandex, yoga pants, halter tops, etc are not acceptable. Leggings do not count as pants. If your outfit is against dress code without leggings, it is against dress code with leggings.
- No clothing bearing a liquor advertisement, tobacco advertisement, suggestive sayings or images will be allowed.
- Anything that appears inappropriate in the judgement of the Camp Director will not be allowed.
- Anyone who is wearing something deemed inappropriate will kindly and discretely be asked to go change and explained as to what is the issue. This is a Bible Camp and we are attempting to have fun, teach life lessons, and above all, Glorifying God.

Rules & Disciplinary Policy

1. No one is to leave camp without permission. We take safety very serious. (Strictly enforced!)
2. No tobacco in any form, alcoholic beverages or drugs (without prescription)
3. No fires. No fireworks. No dangerous items that might even look like fire. We will handle the fires if we are allowed to.
4. Kamp Kinship allows no pets. We abide by their rules. The reason: Pets provide entertainment for the wildlife in the area.
5. No guns or knives. Again, safety for everyone.
6. No unauthorized fires.
7. No unauthorized swimming.
8. No unauthorized shaving cream use.
9. Unless it is cabin time, no one is allowed at the cabins without counselor permission.
10. No Bullying or negative behavior towards other people.
11. No defacing or cutting of trees, shrubs, building or grounds.
12. No profanity, either spoken or written. No need for that here.
13. No CD players, iPods, Cell Phones, etc If it plays music, it will be held by a counselor until the end of the week. (One whole week to unplug. Proof it can happen!)
14. Absolutely NO cameras in the cabins, restrooms or shower facilities.
15. Attendance at Bible Class is mandatory for all campers, regardless of age.
16. All outgoing calls are to be approved by a director. It is available to use, just ask for permission.
17. Kitchen Patrol Duty is to be completed and each camper will be asked to serve on kitchen cleanup.
18. Dismissal from your cabin on Saturday morning will only be after cabins are cleaned and a director's inspection is complete.
19. No one is allowed to leave the camp premises without permission from the Camp Director and the Camp Safety Officer. Anyone leaving the campsite will be required to sign the sign out sheet.
20. Any canteen items will be consumed in or around the dining hall, not in the bunkhouses.
21. All campers and counselors must be in their bunkhouses for rest time. Only exception granted by Camp Director

Packing List
What to Bring to Camp

- BIBLE - Bring your Bible, we'll use it everyday! It's a life changing book! And it's a book, not the digital type...
- Bedding - It can get a little chilly at night. Bring a warm sleeping bag and pillow, or sheets and blankets. Bunks and mattresses are provided in the cabins. You will need the rest.
- Toiletries - Showers are available, and, everyone will get to use them. Bring your own soap, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrush. No sharing of toothbrushes allowed.
- Towels - Might come in handy after the shower. We also have swimming so you might need a couple extra.
- Flashlight - comes in handy at night.
- Swimsuit - Bring a towel and girls are suggested to bring a cover up.

- Clothes - Goes without saying but you never know. A couple of pairs of shoes in case we get a downpour or occasional hail storm.
- Jacket - Prepare for hot days, cool nights, sunshine, rain and a possible hailstorm. We have experienced it all. Come prepared!
